

# Richard Michael McDaniel Endowment Fund Grant 2025 Request for Proposals

The McDaniel Endowment Fund of the Foundation of Yuma Regional Medical Center was established by Richard Michael McDaniel in memory of his parents, Ted and Stella McDaniel. Through his estate, Mr. McDaniel left a generous legacy to be used to further cancer treatment and research in Yuma, Arizona.

The Foundation of Yuma Regional Medical Center is currently accepting applications for grants through December 06, 2024. The funds may be utilized for medical student or physician fellowships, nursing fellowships, cancer research, medical equipment for the YRMC Cancer Center or other activities centered on the awareness, diagnosis, and treatment of cancer in the Yuma area.

Applications will be accepted from 501(c)3 organizations or organizations that have a fiduciary arrangement with a 501(c)3 organization. Individuals are not eligible for this award and may apply for the Richard Michael McDaniel Endowment Fund Scholarship. The Committee will accept grant requests ranging from \$1,000 to \$50,000. The number of grants awarded will vary depending on the number of requests received.

Applications will be asked to submit a detailed budget. Applications must be received by 5:00 pm MST on December 06, 2024. Paper Applications will not be accepted.

### Allowable Expenses:

- Salaries and fringe benefit for program staff
- Supplies
- Travel
- Equipment
- Clinical services or patient care costs
- Medical or scientific research
- Fellowships
- Other direct program expenses
- Indirect Costs, not to exceed 15% of Direct Costs

## **Unallowable Expenses:**

- Political campaigns or lobbying
- Debt reduction
- Annual fund-raising campaigns
- Event sponsorship
- Capital campaigns

#### **Review Process**

The grant application will be reviewed by the McDaniel Endowment Fund Committee based on the following selection criteria:

- Capacity The organization must demonstrate the expertise to implement the proposed project.
- Impact The proposed project must demonstrate a positive impact on the care, diagnosis, treatment, or research of cancer in Yuma. The impact must be measurable and commensurate with the proposed budget.
- Feasibility The proposed project must be achieved within the scope of the award period (1 year). The actions, proposed results, and budget must be realistic.
