

Memorial Bricks



Alfredo Gonzalez, R.N., found himself fighting for his life in the very ICU where he had once cared for others. Struck by COVID-19, he experienced firsthand the compassion of his colleagues as they nursed him back to health. After a hard-fought battle, Alfredo finally left the hospital with a deep sense of gratitude. "I was happy to go home," he recalls, "and eager to come back and help out."

Today, Alfredo continues to serve, driven by his own journey of resilience and the unwavering support of his healthcare family.

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, our ICU staff created a tribute wall to honor patients who had passed away. They placed a star with each patient's name on a temporary wall, set up as part of our pandemic safety measures. This wall soon became a meaningful space for the team to reflect and find comfort amidst the challenges they faced.

Inspired by the Star Wall, this permanent memorial features over 800 laser-cut stars – each representing a life lost to COVID-19 in Yuma County. As Dr. Robert J. Trenschel, President and CEO, noted, "This memorial is a lasting symbol of our journey through one of the most challenging times in our history."

On March 4, 2024, we unveiled the memorial during a small ceremony dedicated to those who lost their lives. Two employees – themselves survivors of lengthy COVID-19 hospital stays – performed the unveiling of the memorial's plaque.

The launch of the Building Hope campaign continues our legacy of celebrating loved ones. By donating a brick, our community will leave a lasting message of gratitude while helping raise funds for our future.


